



Tennis Team Goes Undefeated

The Coppell Cowboy tennis team extended their winning streak to 5 matches in a row after taking down district rival Lake Highlands 17-2 this week. The win improves their overall record to 5-1 (2-0) in district. Going into last night, the Cowboys were in a 3-way tie for 1st place in District 9-6A. Lake Highlands, Richardson, and Coppell all entered this week undefeated. Now Coppell and Richardson share the district lead with identical 2-0 records.

The boys swept the Wildcats with all players winning in straight sets. Lake Highlands was able to eek out a couple of close victories at the top of their girls' lineup, but the rest of the cowgirls won in straight sets.

The tennis team will put their winning streak on the line this afternoon as they travel to Grapevine to take on last year's 5A state champion. The next district foe for the Cowboys will be WT White (Tues. 9/13). That match will be played at the Fair Oaks Tennis Center.

Broadcom MASTERS 2016 Semifinalist

On Wednesday, September 7, 2016, Akash Vijay (an 8th grader at CMS East) was announced as a [2016 Broadcom MASTERS semifinalist](#). Broadcom MASTERS (Math, Applied Science, Technology and Engineering Rising Stars), is the premier science and engineering competition for middle school students. Vijay competed in the Regional and State Science Fairs making him eligible to apply for this prestigious national competition.

The title of his project - *Cycle Power: Harnessing Human Mechanical Energy into Electrical Energy* involved generating electricity in a cleaner and cost effective way with zero pollution while pedaling a bicycle. This was achieved by using the principle of electromagnetic induction. The electricity generated was then used to charge a low voltage electronic device.
