Important Senior Dates

May 13- Senior Dual Credit Meeting 2nd & 5th period in Library Classroom

12th grade dual credit students will complete a Senior Guidance Survey (all other students will do this through their English class). Afternoon dual credit students will be sent by their 2nd period teacher to complete it and morning dual credit student by their 5th period teacher. Items to be completed on this survey will be:

- Post high school plans-what

secondary school you be attending, military, technical school, etc

- Scholarships-bring knowledge or know what scholarships you have been awarded, not just ones you will use. This information will be used as part of the Senior Awards Assembly.
- Questionnaire-give us feedback on the college process, advice to 9th graders, etc.

Also, information will be distributed as to how you send your final transcript to the college you will be attending.

Seniors who are currently taking a dual credit classes on their own-NOT IN THE BLOCK program- must order their transcripts from North Lake by Friday, May 20th. Note-Students in the North Lake Block Program do not need to order transcripts-North Lake has a list of those students and will deliver those transcripts to CHS.

PROFESSIONAL DRESS

- Young Men—dress slacks, dress shoes, collared shirt and tie.
- Young Ladies—dresses, dressy slacks and nice shoes.
- No shorts, flip flops, sandals, etc. will be allowed.

Reminders:

- Be aware that NO AIR HORNS are allowed in the Coliseum. These devices are very irritating and can be harmful especially to those people who wear hearing aids. If air horns are used during the ceremony, they will be taken up by the Coliseum staff when they are detected. Your help in this matter is greatly appreciated.
- Hand held Laser Pointers are also not allowed in the Coliseum if they are used as a distraction. Should they be detected, they will be taken up by Coliseum personnel.
- Please be respectful of others by not using cell phones, or other devices that might detract from the importance of the ceremony.
- Seating will be on a first come, first serve basis. No reserve tickets will be issued.

Incoming Graduation Traffic

Fouts Field (Lot #20) and other close lots (#21 & #27) will be the main parking area for high school graduations. The majority of the traffic will be coming through the North Texas Blvd (NTB) exit. These lots will get full and there will be a large amount of traffic congestion at the NTB exit of I-35 and the intersections close to the lot and the Coliseum. We encourage everyone to take the alternative routes both into and out of campus listed below utilizing parking in the remote lots on the map to lessen waiting times and traffic congestion.

Alternatives to avoid traffic congestion @ North Texas Blvd

I-35E (from Lewisville, Carrollton, Dallas)

Exit Ft. Worth Dr. or McCormick, take a right heading north, turn left on Eagle Dr. and park in the UNT student resident hall

parking lots along Eagle Dr. (Lots #22, #23, #31, and #32) and other student parking along Maple and Highland (Lots #24, #25, #30, #33, #34, #36, and #42).

I-35W (from Ft. Worth)

Take Bonnie Brae exit, turn left on Bonnie Brae, turn right onto W Hickory St., turn right onto Ave D and utilize the remote lots along Ave D (Lots #4, #5, #6, #7, and #11).

I-35 (from Sanger, Gainesville, Oklahoma)

Take Oak St exit, turn left under I-35 continue straight, go through first light and first stop sign, take a right on Ave D and utilize the remote lots along Ave D (Lots #4, #5, #6, #7, and #11).

Hwy 380 (from McKinney, Allen, Frisco)

Continue on 380 (University Dr.) through Denton, take a left on Bonnie Brae, left on W Hickory, right on Ave D and utilize the remote lots along Ave D (Lots #4, #5, #6, #7, and #11).

Hwy 380 (from Decatur, Ponder, Justin)

Continue on 380 (University Dr.) as it goes underneath I-35, take a right on Bonnie Brae, left
