

From CISD School Board Policy EIC Local which establishes our current 6.0 GPA weighting scale:

CISD courses are categorized and weighted as Level IV, Level III, Level II, and Level I.

Level IV Courses are Advanced Placement (AP), some International Baccalaureate (IB), and other rigorous courses as determined by the CISD Curriculum Department.

Level III Courses are Honors courses, Dual Credit courses, some IB courses, and other designated courses.

Level II Courses are academic, extracurricular, and co-curricular courses not categorized and weighted as Level IV or Level II.

Level I Courses are eligible local credit courses.

The District convert semester grades earned in eligible courses to grade points, in accordance with the following chart, and shall calculate a weighted GPA:

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Level II Courses are academic, extracurricular, and co-curricular courses not categorized and weighted as Level IV or Level II.

\*Level I courses are not part of the calculation as they are not courses that meet graduation requirements.
