Early Action Application

What does early action mean? It guarantees the learner a spot at NTH@C before the normal deadline (yay! No lottery).

Who can apply early action? Any 8th grader that resides in the Coppell ISD boundary (this includes current CISD learners and learners attending private schools who would otherwise be attending a CISD campus) can apply for early action.

Am I still required to attend an information session? Yes, all families (with the exception of legacy learners) are required to attend one of the information session dates.

Will I receive confirmation of early action? To verify that your application has been submitted, we have set up the google form so that it will send you a confirmation email. This means that we have your application. All early action participants will receive a follow up email the week of January 18th with additional information about course registration.

What if I apply early action and change my mind later? CISD Board Policy FDB (local) provides guidelines for how to make changes. The deadline to make a change is April 30th.
