To succeed in school and prepare for your future, it's important that you choose your courses wisely.

Developing a four year high school plan will help ensure that you take the courses required for graduation, the courses you need to achieve your goals, and the electives you want to take.

As you develop your four year plan, here are some things to keep in mind:

- Graduation Requirements - When making a four year plan, first fill in all of your required courses (see pg 7 of Course Guide).
- Career Interests - Add in courses that will help you prepare for the career field(s) you're interested in. This will most likely be your CTE Program of Study courses as appropriate under your chosen endorsement.
- Electives- Complete your four year plan with courses that will help you develop new skills, expand your horizons, and pursue your interests.
- Learners will need to include any high school credit courses taken during middle school in the Middle School Courses column.
- Pay close attention to the number of periods/credits for each course.
 - Critical Literacies (English 1 and Digital Applications) is 2 periods AND 2 credits
 - Athletics, Silver Stars, Lariettes, and Cheer are 2 periods BUT 1 credit
 - Band is 2 periods AND 2 credits
