

## **2013-2014 CHS-Social Studies Department Academic Policies**

### **CHS Social Studies Department - Reassessment Policy**

Learners will have the opportunity to take a reassessment if their initial assessment grade is lower than a 70. In order to be eligible for the reassessment, a learner must first attend 2 tutorial sessions with the educator. Further, the highest grade possible for the reassessment will be a 70.

### **CHS Social Studies Department - Academic Dishonesty Policy**

Any learner that is observed to be participating in an act that does not reflect academic integrity will be subject to the following actions: 1) Parent/Guardian will be contacted 2) Assistant Principal of learner will be contacted for Disciplinary Referral 3) Learner will receive a grade of 0 for assessment 4) Learner will be allowed to take a Reassessment with the following stipulation.... (B) highest grade possible for the reassessment will be a 65.

### **CHS – Late Work Policy**

As per the Student Handbook, all (10-12<sup>th</sup> grade) learners enrolled in Social Studies classes at Coppell High School are not allowed to turn in work after the due date (late work).

**\*\* (9th Grade learners ONLY) \*\*** 9th Grade learners in Social Studies classes are allowed to turn in assignments after the due date (late work) up to a maximum of 1 day late for a maximum grade of a 70. Projects and major assignments may be turned in up to a maximum of 1 day late for a maximum grade of 85.
