Dear CISD Family,

The Coppell ISD Board of Trustees approved new elementary and middle school attendance boundaries for the district during its meeting Feb. 25, 2019. The new boundaries were adopted in preparation for the opening of CISD's 11th elementary school, Canyon Ranch Elementary, in Irving (Valley Ranch) in August 2019, as well to optimize student capacity at facilities while accommodating student growth in the southern portion of the district.

The district and our Board of Trustees embarked on a boundary realignment process in May of 2018. The collective team has been thoughtful and intentional throughout this process collecting input from all CISD stakeholder groups in a variety of ways. The task of balancing the needs of our families and educational programs, while maximizing land and space available, as well as transportation needs, has been challenging and thoughtful. Now we begin the work of ensuring all our parent and student communities know the outcomes, the impacts to their family and next steps to prepare for the 2019-2020 school year. “GRANDFATHERING” REQUESTS

Current fourth and seventh graders will be allowed to finish their fifth grade and eighth grade years, respectively, at their current school for the 2019-2020 school year, if they choose. Siblings of these students also would be allowed to remain at the current campus for one year only. Transfer forms must be completed for each “grandfathered” student and sibling in order to be eligible.

STUDENT TRANSFER REQUESTS (INTRA-DISTRICT)

Students who reside in the Coppell ISD boundaries and are currently enrolled in a Coppell ISD school and would like to request a transfer to another Coppell ISD school must complete a transfer request form annually. All students attending their current school on a transfer must complete a transfer request form to remain at the transfer school or the 2019-2020 school year. As a condition of every approved transfer is the requirement that the student maintain prompt and regular attendance (90%), good behavior, passing grades in all areas and space availability at the receiving campus. 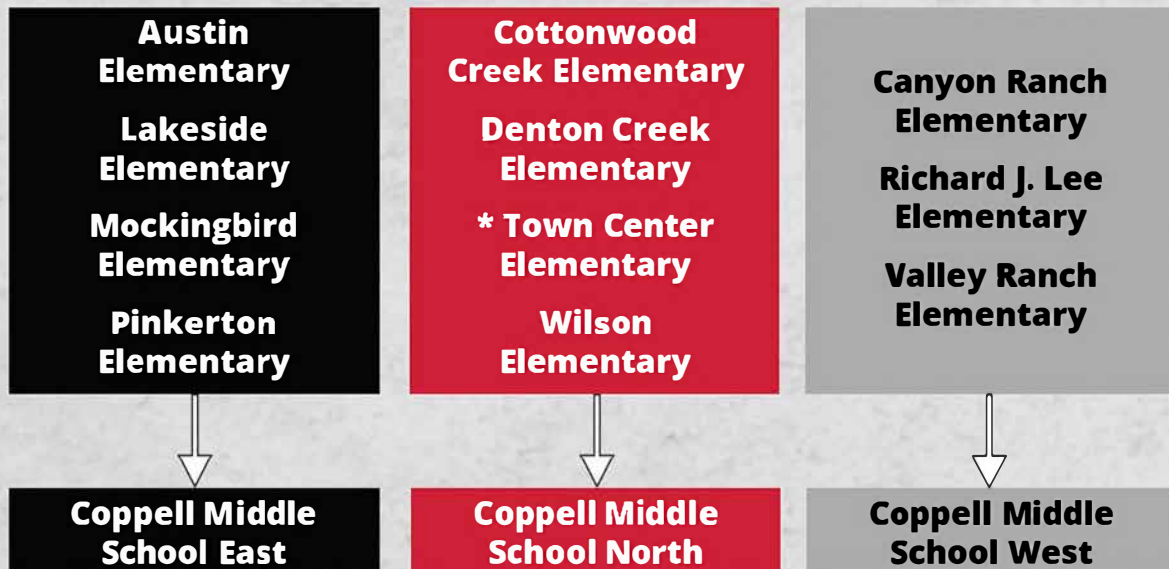
The “grandfathering” and transfer request form can be found at www.coppellisd.com/realignment and must be completed and hand delivered to the receptionist at the Vonita White Administration Building, 200 S. Denton Tap Road, Coppell. Transfer requests must be approved by the Superintendent’s Designee before a student may change schools.

The transfer application window will be from March 4 to March 29. Decisions will be communicated to applicants by April 30, 2019. Decisions are final and cannot be appealed.

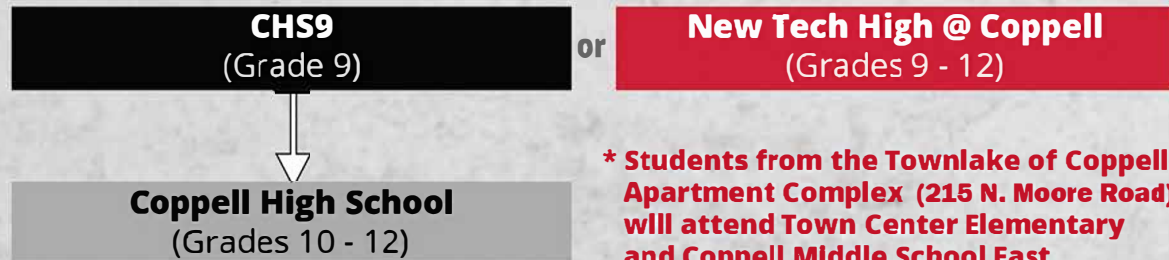
IMPORTANT TRANSPORTATION NOTE:

- CISD will not provide transportation for students who transfer campuses, including those who transfer as “grandfathered” students.
- There will not be a “pay-to-ride” option for either “grandfathered” or transfer students.
