

Policy Updates

❖ BE(Local): Board Meetings (replace policy)

- As a means to ensure that items included on Board Meeting agendas are timely and appropriate topics to include, an update that requires all topics to be submitted in writing by at least two Board members is being requested.

❖ FDA(Local): Admissions – Interdistrict Transfers (replace policy)

- In order to maximize the programs offered at New Tech High at Coppell as well as to bring in additional revenue to CISE to support the programs, a revision to this policy has been written that would permit a student who qualifies for Open Enrollment to enter CISD as a high school student and to attend NTH@C for his/her high school experience.

❖ FNCE(Local): Student Conduct-Personal Telecommunications/Electronic Devices (replace policy)

- As student-tracking safety devices are becoming more advanced, many now include recording or listen-in capabilities. Because of student privacy concerns, the updated policy would allow the District to require listen-in technology to be disabled while the device is on a campus.

❖ Update 110

- Update 110 focuses on updating and reorganizing several policies in the BB series of the policy manual addressing board member eligibility and qualifications, elections, and vacancies and removal from office. There is one local policy that is impacted.

• BBB(Local): Board Members – Elections (replace policy)

- This change places district choices about elections processes in a local policy and not a legal policy which is consistent with the structure of other policies in the manual.
