Instructions for Authorization Agreement for Voluntary Adult Caregiver

<u>Chapter 34 of the Texas Family Code</u> allows a parent to authorize certain relatives or voluntary caregivers in a Parental Child Safety Placement to take specified actions and obtain services on behalf of a child if the parent is unable to for some reason. As required by <u>Senate Bill 1598</u>, <u>81 Regular Session</u>, DFPS developed <u>The Authorization Agreement for Voluntary Adult Caregiver</u> to assist families in meeting the requirements of the law. The form is not a DFPS-specific form, and is intended for use by any family that wants to ensure a child's needs are being met in the parents' absence.
