



Back-to-School IN-PERSON CHECKLIST



As we prepare to welcome those who have chosen in-person learning back to campus on Tuesday, September 8, here are some helpful tips to ensure your student is ready to learn!

ARRIVAL/DISMISSAL

- Be at school on time – no early drop-offs allowed.
- Upon dismissal, immediately leave the building.
- Students involved in after-school activities must report to designated areas within 10 minutes of dismissal.
- Parents picking up students during the day will call ahead so that students can be sent or accompanied to parent vehicles upon arrival. Parents cannot enter building to pick up their child during the school day.

MEDICAL SCREENING

- Students and staff should prescreen themselves for any of the following COVID-19 symptoms prior to coming to school: fever of 100 degrees fahrenheit or higher, loss of taste or smell, cough, difficulty breathing, shortness of breath, headache, chills, sore throat, shaking or exaggerated shivering, significant muscle pain or ache and diarrhea. Anyone with the symptoms should NOT come to school or visit a CISD facility.
- Teachers will monitor students and refer to the nurse if symptoms are present.

FACE MASK

- Students in Pre-K through 12th grade will wear face coverings during substantial and moderate transmission levels, including in the classroom.
- Wear your face mask properly covering your nose and mouth.
- Staff may be wearing additional PPE, including gloves, scrubs or shields, as needed.

PRACTICE HEALTH AND SAFETY PROTOCOLS

- Students and staff will be trained in proper hand washing protocols to prevent COVID-19 and the spread of germs.
- Students and staff will be trained in proper social distancing.
- After a restroom break, students will be required to wash their hands and/or use hand sanitizer before reentering the classroom.

LUNCHROOM SAFETY PROTOCOLS

- Teachers will monitor in the cafeteria and hallways to ensure social distancing.
- Depending on the number of students enrolled in grades PK-5, plans for lunches to be eaten in the cafeteria, as well as the classroom, will be developed accordingly.
- Microwaves will not be provided in the cafeteria.
- CISD is encouraging cashless payments. Make payments at www.myschoolbucks.com
- If a student pays with cash, the change will be put on his lunch account. No cash will be given out.
- No parents/visitors allowed during lunch, at least for the fall semester.
