



Back-to-School REMOTE CHECKLIST



As we prepare for remote and in-person learning on Tuesday, September 8, here are some helpful tips to ensure your remote student is ready to learn!

DAILY STUDENT RESPONSIBILITIES

- Prepare your device – make sure it is fully charged and has access to internet.
- Be prepared for learning each day by logging into Schoology first thing in the morning.
- Attend live Zoom sessions offered by the educator.
- Complete assignments and tasks as required by the educator.
- Review educator feedback on learning.

STUDENT EXPECTATIONS

- Students are required to login to Schoology each morning to interact with learning and submit your daily assignments.
- Attendance requirements (as required by the TEA) will be documented by the interactions with educators and the engagement level with lessons and assignments within Schoology.
- Remote learning will follow a typical daily schedule depending on the campus and grade level.
- Students who are not available to engage in lessons and activities during the regular school day will have until 11:59 p.m. to complete assignments and tasks, and to be counted as present for the day.

COMMUNICATION

- Students/parents can contact the teachers through email.
- Teachers will respond to assignment-related questions within the regular school day. Teachers will respond to other questions within one work day.
- Teachers will provide instructions for assignments and tasks in Schoology each day.
