



In the spring, the District established a committee, the Reopening Task Force, that is hard at work preparing for a successful 2020-2021 school year. This group of leaders representing all departments and campus levels are working in conjunction with the district's executive leadership team and cabinet leadership to develop plans for maintaining continuity of instruction for students, maintaining operations, and prioritizing the health and safety of students and staff. Our district's core values will remain as a filter for all decisions of this Task Force: Great Teaching, Redefining Success, Collective Engagement and Authentic Relationships. As part of the process, this team will review feedback from our community, staff, students, and families. The feedback is important as the district plans for the upcoming school year.

The Coppel ISD administration surveyed its families and employees measuring their input and feedback on returning to work and school for the summer and fall. Families completed 7,698 surveys while staff members completed 1,560 surveys providing valuable input to the Task Force. Every campus, building, and grade level was represented in the survey responses. The survey data will be one source of data used by the Task Force to develop a plan for school in the fall.

Beginning July 8, Coppel ISD will again survey families and staff again seeking additional feedback on the Return to School plan. Through ongoing communication and input, the Task Force will work to develop a plan that meets the needs of all CISD learners and staff.

One of the key feedback points from the Return to School surveys is the top priorities identified by both the staff and parents. Both parents and staff agreed on some key priorities to focus on as the district develops a Return to School plan.

- 1,178 listed **keeping myself and my family healthy** as a top priority.
- 1,163 listed providing an **appropriate education and enrichment** for students as a top priority.
- 775 listed the importance of **socialization opportunities for students** as a top priority.

**Parents:**

- 6,581 listed providing an **appropriate education and enrichment** for students as a top priority.
- 6,129 listed **keeping myself and my family healthy** as a top priority.
- 4,300 listed the importance of **socialization opportunities for students** as a top priority.
