- return to CISD as an employee on the first instructional day of the 2011-2012 school year (exception would be retirement).
- be employed on or before October 1, 2010.
- be a 3rd-5th grade content teacher (Math, ELA, Social Studies & Science) or secondary mathematics teacher through Algebra1 only. This includes special education mathematics teachers and ESL mathematics teachers.
- provide documentation when requested by campus administration regarding students' achievements.
- realize that payout will occur during the 2011-2012 school year; therefore, I must return and be employed by CISD; if I am no longer a CISD employee then I am not eligible.
- understand that guidelines regarding student data (who, when, what, where, & how) is determined by district administrators.
- achieve district required improvement expectation as defined by D.A.T.E Grant.
- achieve school campus required improvement expectation as defined in D.A.T.E. Grant.
- be in good standing in 2010-2011 year, not under investigation, or reassigned pending investigation at the time awards are distributed. Employees are ineligible for awards until any investigation is concluded and the employee is cleared of the allegation. Note: a teaching reassignment can change eligibility status.
