What is Off-Campus PE?

- ▶ A way to accommodate students who are making a serious effort to develop high level capabilities and to allow them to be involved in an off-campus program that provides training exceeding that offered in the school district.
- ▶ is a cooperative arrangement between the Coppell Independent School District and an approved off-campus sponsoring facility/agency. Activities are defined as those in which a student works with either a single teacher/coach or with a team teacher/coach at an approved agency during the regular school year.

What Sports Are Considered?

Only students involved in the following activities will be considered for Off-Campus Physical Education: **DANCE, EQUESTRIAN, FENCING, GYMNASTICS, ICE HOCKEY, ICE SKATING, MARTIAL ARTS, GOLF, ROCK CLIMBING, ROWING, SQUASH, SWIMMING, TENNIS, AND CYCLING.**



Which OCPE Is Best For My Student?

▶ **CATEGORY ONE**

- ▶ This is a highly accelerated program comparable to an Olympic/collegiate training level (**scholarship bound**) that requires a minimum of fifteen (15) hours per week of highly intense, professionally supervised training by the student under the supervision of credentialed and/or certified instructors. Practices must take place over five separate days and at least four of these days must be Monday - Friday.
- ▶ Students qualifying at this level **may be dismissed** from school **ONE PERIOD PER DAY** (either the first or the last period of the day) for such participation.
- ▶ Transportation must be arranged by the parents. Students must arrive and/or depart school in a manner that does not affect the remainder of his/her classes. Middle schools do not provide study halls for students who are in OCPE.

Which OCPE Is Best For My Student?

▶ CATEGORY TWO

- ▶ These programs are to be of high quality, well supervised by appropriately trained instructors, and consisting of a minimum of five (5) hours per week. Practices must take place over four separate days and at least three of these days must be Monday - Friday.
- ▶ Students certified to participate at this level **MAY NOT be dismissed** from any part of the regular school day.

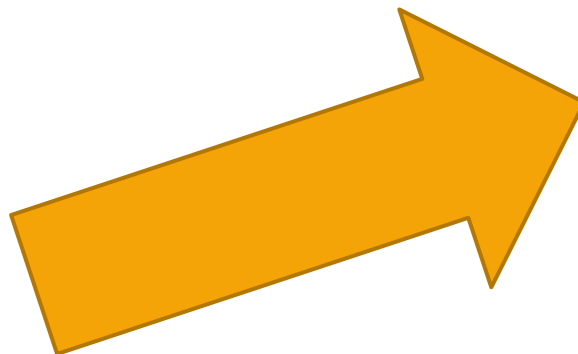
