



On October 13<sup>th</sup>, Coppell High School will administer the PSAT/NMSQT to all 10<sup>th</sup> and 11<sup>th</sup> grade students. The PSAT/NMSQT is given each year to all tenth and eleventh grade students enrolled in Coppell ISD at no cost to the student or their family. The PSAT/NMSQT is an assessment which measures the skills and knowledge needed for college readiness and success. The test is also used to qualify for scholarships with the National Merit Scholarship program.
