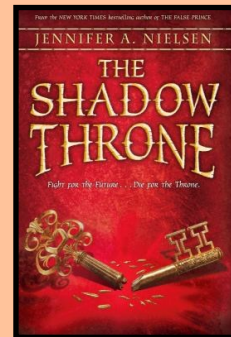
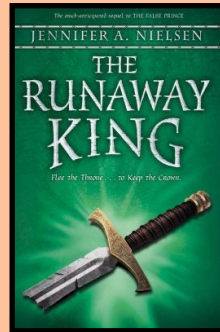
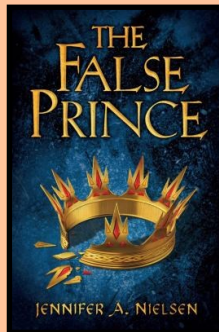
Summer Reading

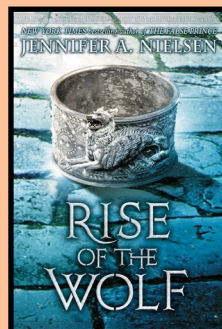
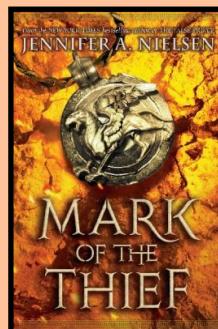
Young adult author **Jennifer Nielsen** will visit all middle schools in September. Coppell ISD recommends that learners read one or more of her books over the summer.
